One Step at a Time

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - cut 8 - 10" x 10" (center designs evenly)

Fabric B - ** cut 1 - 23 1/2" x 33 1/2" (center design evenly)

Fabric D - cut lengthwise 1 - 10 1/4" x 25 1/2" (TOP) and 1 - 10 1/4" x 25 1/2" (BOTTOM), see colored picture for strip placement

Fabric E - pocket - cut 4 - 10 1/2" x 6 3/4"

cut 4 - 3 3/4" x 10" (back of pocket)

Fabric F - **cut 2 - 1 1/2" x 33 1/2" (SIDES) and 2 - 1 1/2" x 25 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

cut 6 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end then subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 55" (SIDES) and 2 - 1 1/2" x 46 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

Fabric G - pocket - cut 4 - 10 1/2" x 6 3/4"

cut 4 - 3 3/4" x 10" (back of pocket)

cut 2 - 4" x 10"

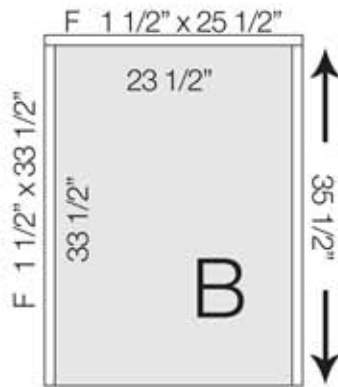
Fabric H - cut 6 - 2 3/4" strips, sew end to end then subcut 2 - 2 3/4" x 57" (SIDES) and 2 - 2 3/4" x 51" (TOP and BOTTOM)

Fabric I - BINDING - cut 6 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

2. Piecing Order:

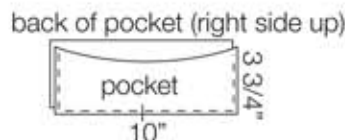
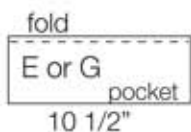
1. First, sew **F** borders around center panel **B**, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.

** (If panel measurements are slightly different, cut **F** borders slightly larger, sew around center panel, then trim center block to measure 25 1/2" x 35 1/2".)



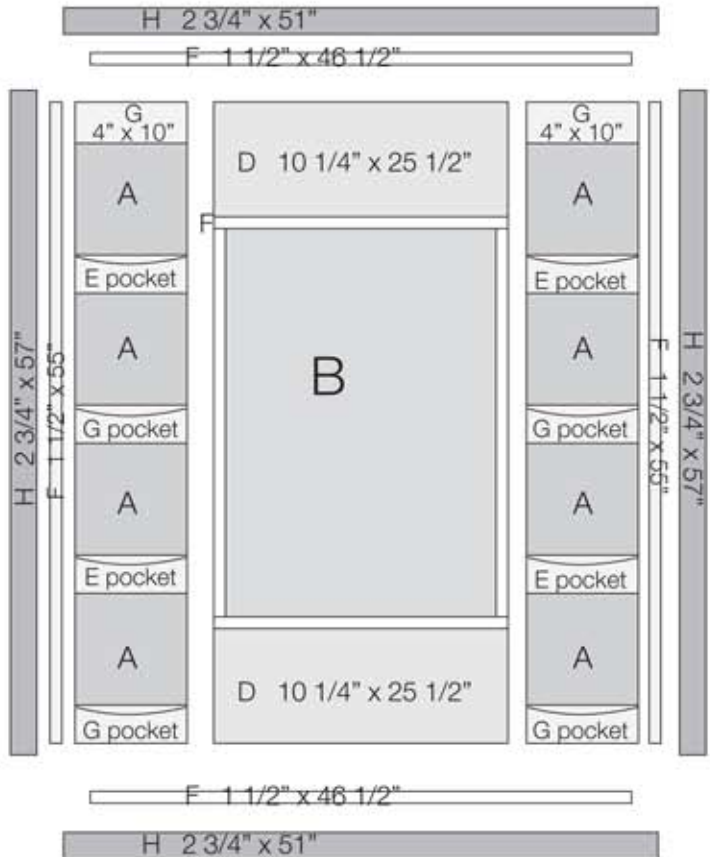
2. Next, sew Border Stripe **D** above and below center block (see diagram on right).

3. Make pockets by folding **E** and **G** 10 1/2" x 6 3/4" pieces in half, right sides out. Next, topstitch close to the folded edge of each pocket. Place pocket over back pocket (3 3/4" x 10") right side up, matching sides and bottom raw edges. The pocket is slightly larger than back pieces so fold over extra fullness on the bottom of pocket. Stitch both sides and bottom of pocket to the back piece with a scant 1/4" seam allowance. Repeat for all pockets (8).



4. Sew **G** rectangle on top then alternate **A** blocks and pockets for the SIDES. Sew SIDE borders to the quilt center according to the diagram.

5. Sew individual **F** and **H** borders to the quilt, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.



6. The quilt measures approximately 51" x 61". Make backing (**Fabric C**) at least 6" larger than the top. Layer top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric I**), fill pockets with toys and enjoy!!
